Report from <i>ad hoc</i> committee on Plagiarism in GSBS Theses and Dissertations	Dr. Cunningham gave a definition of <i>plagiarism</i> and <i>self-plagiarism</i> . The current percentage allowed for plagiarism is 15% (5%) from a single source. More clarification of plagiarism was recommended for incoming students. The committee suggested that Research Proposals, Theses and Dissertations get submitted through Turn-It-In. If Turn-It-In finds plagiarism, the advisory committee is responsible for evaluating the issue. A final version of the document with the Turn-It-In results should be submitted to the GSBS office.
