COMMUNITY GARDEN

Our Community Garden was established in 2014 and has 35 plots all managed by students, employees, and community members. Twenty five percent is donated to local food banks or our own student food pantry.



PUBLIC TRANSIT & CHARGE STATIONS

Students receive discounts on monthly and annual transit passes throughout the region!

We also have EV charging stations on campus.

FW BIKE SHARE

FW Bike Share is a city-wide network of bike stations, and we have a station in front of the library. Students receive a FREE annual membership (use code "untstudent").



REDUCE/REUSE

We have over 40 water refill stations on campus! So bring your own bottle to class, meetings, etc. and refuse single-use plastic bottles.

Also, bring your own fork/spoon to the cafés.

These small actions really make a difference!



RECYCLING



We offer co-mingle recycling all over campus that collects paper, paperboard, empty and clean plastics, cardboard, and cans all in one bin.

We also recycle batteries, ink cartridges, and cell phones in special bins in the library and MET by the cafés.

LAB EFFICIENCY ACTION PROGRAM (LEAP)

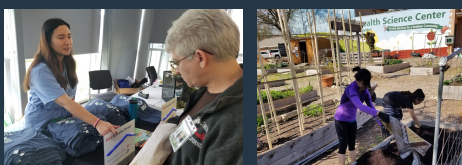
LEAP is an incentive program that awards labs for operating more sustainably. Labs can be earn up to \$3000!
