About the Committee & Committee Business

Minutes: Minutes from the previous meeting were sent prior to this meeting. A motion was made by Betsy Friauf to approve the minutes, and Myles Quiben seconded the motion. The vote carried and the minutes were approved.

Announcements

- Freezer Replacements We are replacing up to 4 ultra-low freezers on campus with more efficient units. Researchers can apply for a replacement through a form online. Check the Daily News for the link.
- ➤ <u>Week: Transit 101 –</u> This is a lunchtime event where we teach people to ride public transit, and we are doing it as part of Wellness Week. It will be March 5 at noon. Details on the Wellness Week flyer.
- ➤ Recycling Changes We will be changing our co-mingle recycling soon. Reasons include high contamination rate, excessive plastic bags, China's change in what they accept (historically the US sends about 30% of our recycling there), emphasize a focus on reduction, etc. We will be changing signs, perhaps changing door colors/openings, etc. The committee brainstormed ideas to help the rollout of this change such as the following:
 - o Focus on education such as the process of recycling and its issues, the costs of recycling, why reducing and reusing are what we should focus on, etc.
 - o Perhaps have a recycling quiz/survey where participants can be entered to win a gift card.
 - o Entertaining yet education video on recycling
 - Educate students at departmental orientations (we currently have a table at the orientation fairs for each school, but this would allow us to get in front
- ➤ <u>Water Station Volunteers</u> We need a few more volunteers to report water station counts at the end of each month. If you're interested, let Sandy know.

Subcommittee Updates

- Community Garden: We have several events planned for the spring including a Bed Prep Day this past weekend.
 Other events coming up include Planting Day on April 6, and a Lunch & Learn on April 11th. We are still planning on being featured both internally and externally in newsletters/magazines for our 5th year celebration.
- Lab Efficiency Action Program (LEAP): We are requiring labs that get a freezer replacement to participate in the program and we currently have 2 labs that are undergoing re-certification.
- ➤ RRR (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) Subcommittee This subcommittee is focusing on making lunches, break rooms, meetings, etc. more sustainable and eco-friendly. This work will continue next term when we can find a person to cochair this group.
