What is NorTex?

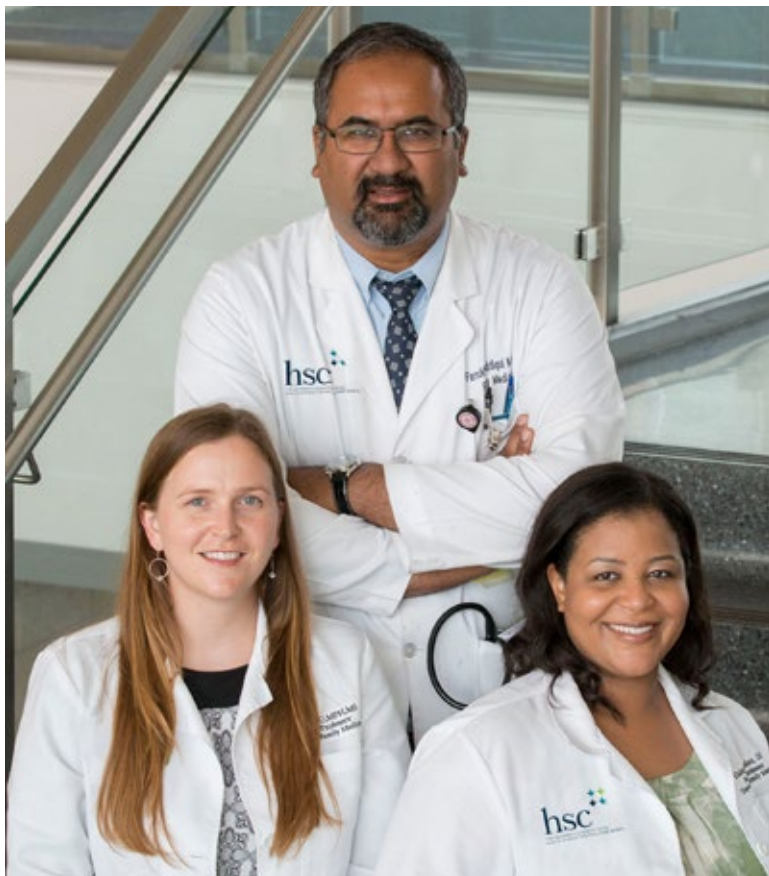
NorTex is a primary care practice-based research network (PBRN) which functions as a collaborative effort to conduct research among North Texas primary care practices, including family medicine, general internal medicine, pediatrics, geriatrics, and obstetrics/gynecology clinics.

NorTex is housed in the Department of Family Medicine at the University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth. NorTex includes private practices, county health systems, federally qualified health centers, and other primary care / community practices located across the metroplex and in rural Texas. Our overall goal is to revolutionize the way we conduct primary care and public health related research with NorTex being the inter-locking key.
