

#### Overview

The Pediatric Research Program (PRP), offered by the Department of Pediatrics, received a remarkable response for the year 2016. As many as 52 first year students showed interest to join this program. After personal interviews and considering available mentors it was not possible to accommodate all students. Attempts were made to accommodate students' interest to match the research area and mentors. PRP provided research training from 6/8/2016 to 7/8/2016 at UNTHSC, CCMC and CSC. In total, 33 students conducted research under the supervision of 23 (UNTHSC: 7; CCMC: 15; CSC: 1) mentors. Some students worked at two institutions with mentors at both locations.

#### Orientation

PRP students were gathered on 6/8/16 at 7:45 A.M. in LIB110 on UNTHSC campus for the orientation and the first didactic session. W. Paul Bowman, MD introduced the key persons to participants and moderated the 'Welcome & Overview' session. Dean Don Peska, DO graciously visited the session and greeted the students. Dr. Peska provided some tips to students to utilize this opportunity to gain research experience.

The students assigned to CCMC attended orientation and introduction to tools used for the collection and storage of research data. At CCMC, participants were greeted and welcomed by James Marshall, MD, Don P. Wilson, MD and Ms. Debra Jorden. Dr. Marshall emphasized the importance of research in clinical practice. Dr. Wilson has described the research topics, information about mentors and the program guidelines. Ms. Jordan provided instructions to comply with the policies/procedures at CCMC. Dr. Bailey demonstrated required systems/software used to collect and store data at CCMC. Ms. Liz Richards gave the tour of the facilities/departments to PRP students assigned to CCHC.

#### Didactic Lectures

As part of PRP program, students also attended lectures on various topics in five (weekly) didactic sessions.

- i) Research Design and Protocol Development (Presenter: Laurie Bailey, PhD).
- ii) Acting with Integrity (Presenter: Karen Keller, MLS).
- iii) Medical Records Review and Case Study (Presenter: Don P. Wilson, MD).
- iv) Introduction to Data Analysis and Interpretation (Presenter: Tyler Hamby, PhD).
- v) Tips for Presentations & Publications; (Presenter: Riyaz Basha, PhD); Next Steps (Presenter: Deep Shah, MD, MPH).

These presentations were recorded and shared with all participants for benefiting PRP students (including absentees for the sessions). Intermediate reports were collected from the students and they are currently working on their final reports. Mid-term survey was obtained after the completion of the second week using i-clickers. It was helpful to identify potential pitfalls and intervene to address the concerns of the participants.

## Mid-term Survey

Majority of students (28 out of 31) were very satisfied with their mentors' contributions in helping them achieve their research goals. Most of the students were very satisfied with accessibility to their faculty mentors (28 out of 31) and project managers (all students). Almost all of the students were satisfied with clarity and practicality of program requirements (29 out of 31) and found the didactic sessions beneficial (25 out of 30).
