Dizziness and confusion



Body weakness



Sleepiness



Slow Breathing



Slow heart rate



Pinpoint Pupils



Face is pale and/or feels cold



Unconsciousness



Vomiting or making gurgling noise



Slow or no responsiveness



DIRECTIONS

CHECK



Step 1: Check for responsiveness

CALL



Step 2: Call 911

Step 3: Open Narcan package

LAY



Step 4: Lay the person on their back

Step 5: Tilt head up by lifting the chin

Step 6: Place tip fully into one nostril

GIVE



Step 7: Push in plunger

Step 8: Place in recovery position

POSITION
